Objective:

***Use vehicle and COMAND manual to answer all questions.**

COMAND System Settings

1. Turn on the COMAND unit, then press the “SERV” button. The system menu should now be showing. Enter into “Time”, what can be adjusted from here?

2. Change the minutes of the time showing. Did the time change in increments of one minute or in increments of 30 minutes? _____ Both are possible even on the same vehicle, what would then make it move in increments of 1 versus increments of 30? _____
3. Reset to correct time. With the “Format” soft key you can change the way the date and time are displayed. What is the other choice for how the time is displayed? _____
4. Using the “Back” button, go back to settings main screen and enter “Lang.” Can you change the language to something different than the instrument cluster displays? YES NO
5. Back out of “language” and then enter into “Tones”. Can you turn “Beep on confirmation” on or off? YES NO
6. Back out of “Tones” and enter “Display”. Notice that there are 3 choices for display setting, leave at the automatic setting. If a customer complained that their display was too bright, could you adjust the brightness down?

7. Next back out of “Display” and enter the “VC Tips” section. Notice that under the “Help Window” you can deactivate the voice control help function. Enter into “Individualization”. Start the individualization, this function does not work at this time on a 211, but does work on a 220, pull level and say “cancel” to stop.
8. Exit out of “Settings”. Make sure to reset any changes that you have made.

Navigation

1. Press the “NAV” or use Voice recognition and say Navigation. You are planning to meet a friend at 250 Vilano Road in St. Augustine, Florida. Use navigation to input the address. Use “Destination entry” to input address. Input house number (250) by using “Hse. No.” After the route is calculated how far away from your location is Vilano Road? _____
2. The automatically generated navigation announcements are superimposed over any other active audio source. How can the volume difference be adjusted and stored?

3. If a customer does not want to hear the voice instructions, how can you mute the voice announcements for one trip?(*note works the same way on a 220)

4. How is the scale of the map changed?

5. On the same screen as the scale buttons there is a “St – over” button. What is this button used for? _____
6. Another new item is the display features. Enter “Display”, change to personal and then use the “Symbols” section to show airports and gas stations. On a map scale setting of 5 miles, do any of these symbols show up?

7. Decrease the map scale until the “Symbols” you selected show on the screen if not showing at the 5 mile scale. Using the owners manual, at what scale does it say all symbols are shown? _____

8. Going back to “Display” what changes when GPS is selected or deselected?
(must look at full map screen)

9. Press the “Map” button, noting screen. Press “Map” button again, what changed with the screen? _____

10. Go back to main Navigation screen and select destination and delete. Did the destination delete? YES NO
